

REMINDER: Visit the Loftus Tramway Museum with the QCC on Wednesday 9 May 2018, (which is just four weeks away).

Come with us and have unlimited tram rides from the old Railway Square waiting shed which stood in the middle of the road near Central until 1953 but now shelters folks going on tram rides from Loftus via the National Park to Sutherland and back.

We will have a guided tour of the property, seeing trams from San Fran, Nagasaki, Berlin, Munich, Milan, Brisbane, Ballarat, Melbourne and the biggy, Sydney. Some are over 100 yrs old. And there are buses, trolley buses, old engines. A real look at ancient transport technology.

Afterwards, there will be a tasty Sausage Sizzle lunch cooked for you on the BBQs in a covered area. You will need to bring your own plates, cups, cutlery and drinks (no corkage charges).

\$30.00 will cover your entry fee, the saus-sizzle, tea and coffee, salad, condiments and dessert. Meet there by 10:00 am opening time and we should be finished by 2:00 pm.

You can come by train to Loftus Station on the Waterfall line, then you follow the signs to the big Khaki shed. Or, you can drive to Pitt St & Princes Highway at Loftus. They have some parking on site and there is a parking area diagonally across from the Museum at Rawson St & Old Princes Highway.
