QCC members and their guests have worked up a winter appetite and we need to address that problem. This year we have decided to go back to Berowra Waters but a little earlier to enjoy a different entertainer. Our last two years have been very popular so you need to book early.



It is only a short drive to find yourself surrounded by the bush, overlooking boats and a magnificent waterway, and having the chance to indulge in a traditional Northern Hemisphere hot Christmas Lunch.

Waterview is an absolute waterfront restaurant with good parking and is air conditioned and fully licensed. Please note that a selection of wines, juices and soft drinks are already included with the lunch. But if you want to BYO you can do so for \$5 per bottle corkage.

Whilst you are being served a delicious freshly prepared three course Christmas Luncheon, we will be entertained by Lucky Starr. Most of you will remember Lucky from Bandstand, the Mavis Bramston Show, and In Melbourne Tonight. For a season he hosted Six O'Clock Rock. His Platinum Award winning hit song was *I've Been Everywhere*.

In 1963, Lucky went overseas and appeared at the Flamingo in Vegas, the Mapes in Reno, Harveys in Lake Tahoe and then spent some years working for the Hilton Hotel chain world-wide.

Lucky was the first Aussie to entertain the troops in Vietnam and did so at his own cost the first time. Later they brought him back five times. He is versatile so expect to hear Rock, Country, Jazz, Whatever.

What about the food? You will get a Sherry on arrival. Then we will have French Vegetable Soup with a freshly baked bread roll. The main course will be Roast Pork Belly, Turkey and roasted vegetables. And, of course, the dessert will be the obligatory Christmas Pudding and Brandy Custard. 

Include the names of the attendees before you post it.


You may want to call Geoff on 0411 020 520 to tell him your cheque is in the mail in case it gets delayed.

HOW DO YOU GET THERE?

If you have your own seaplane or yacht you should not need directions. For the rest of us, it will depend on where you live. If you live in the Hills District it is a no-brainer. Simply go via Dural, Galston, Arcadia, Berrilee and take Bay Road as far as it goes, and 30 minutes after you passed Dural you are there. If you are coming down from the North on the M1, exit to the West at Berowra and go via Berowra Heights to Berowra Ferry and use it to go across to the West Bank and you will be there. Allow 30 minutes for the ferry, From the South go via Hornsby, Mt Colah, Mt Kuring-Gai and turn off the Pacific Highway towards the West at Berowra. You will have to allow time to cross the ferry too. Whichever way you go it will be a lovely day out in the bush! Get there by 11:45 for lunch at Noon. You will get away by 2:30 pm to pick up the grandkids.
